


## THEME SURVEY OF NEW EDUCATION POLICY (5-11-2016)

On this occasion ACD Poonch Dr. Basharat Ahmed also addressed the gathering giving them important information that the Rural Sanitation Department provides financial assistance up to Rs 12000/-to rural household for the construction of a latrine under Swachh Bharat Mission to all Below Poverty Line households. Principal GDC Poonch, Prof. Tajinder Singh also spoke on this occasion and informed the volunteers that 2.5 billion populace worldwide have no access to proper sanitation.





### HERITAGE WALK FROM DEGREE COLLEGE POONCH TO SHRI DASNAMI AKHARA POONCH



On 8<sup>TH</sup> OF SEPTEMBER, 2017, the Department of History in collaboration with IQAC organized a Heritage Walk from the campus of government Degree College Poonch to Shri Dashnami Akhara Poonch The Study Tour as per the curriculum was an exposure trip to educational or historical importance. The tour programme was planned for a day for the students of History. Started from the college at 10:10 A.M with the guidance and company of Prof. Shehzad Bandey, Head Department of history. Dr. Tariq sheikh, lecturer in BCA, the students reached reached the destination at 10:30 A.M.

The students were made to roam in the Akhara complex in which they were shown yatriniwas, big community hall, yatri-cum Pravachan Sthal of Marble spread over 26 kanal area. Then the students were made aware about its history in which they were told that Dashnami Akhara had remained centre of power when Poonch was principality of local Dogra Rajas in 1852-1947 AD. The new Rajas of Poonch would be coronated in Dashnami Akhara temple and then they were taken in procession to Poonch fort for taking oath as Raja of Poonch. The Mahant of Akhara was known as Raj Guru. If one turns the leaves of history one finds that Raja Moti Singh (1852-1892 AD) started shifting his Darbar for about two months from Poonch town to Rajpura Mandi in summer season. It was this period when the ancient temple of Buddha Amarnath, Rajpura Mandi. This temple was contructed by a Muslim Raja Rustam Khan Rathore of Poonch during 1760 to 1787 AD.

After learning about the history the students relaxed and enjoyed there and around 1. P.M the students reached back to the college campus. at 3.30 P.M. In this way the Heritage walk got completed successfully
