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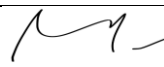
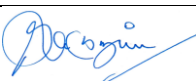
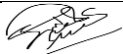
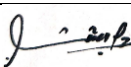
MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF STUDIES MEETING

Shri Krishan Chander Government Degree College Poonch has been accredited with 'A' Grade by NAAC and recently been awarded Autonomous status by UGC vide order No. F.2-10/2023(Ac-Policy) dated 20th February 2026. Consequently, the University of Jammu vide order No. CDC/2026/9724-26 dated 09/03/2026 has authorized the college to function as an Autonomous College with effect from the Academic Session 2026-27.

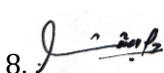
The board urged the teachers to make use of innovative tools in the classroom to enhance students' vocabulary and language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing).
