



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## **Govt. Degree College Poonch and Municipality Committee Poonch Organized different activities**

**Waste Management.** As part of our activities, our College decided to arrange a proper waste management system, since the campus was so dirty with the dumping of waste and plastic everywhere. A sequence of activities was planned with the help of the College P.T.I, Staff and students which included the following steps.

**Step 1 Campus Cleaning:** Around 150 students were selected from two classes and were divided in to five groups and were allotted to clean various areas in the campus. Teachers and PTA members were in charge of these groups. The campus cleaning day was very much effective, since the students could collect almost the entire plastic waste from the campus. The collected non degradable waste was taken by the municipal authorities.

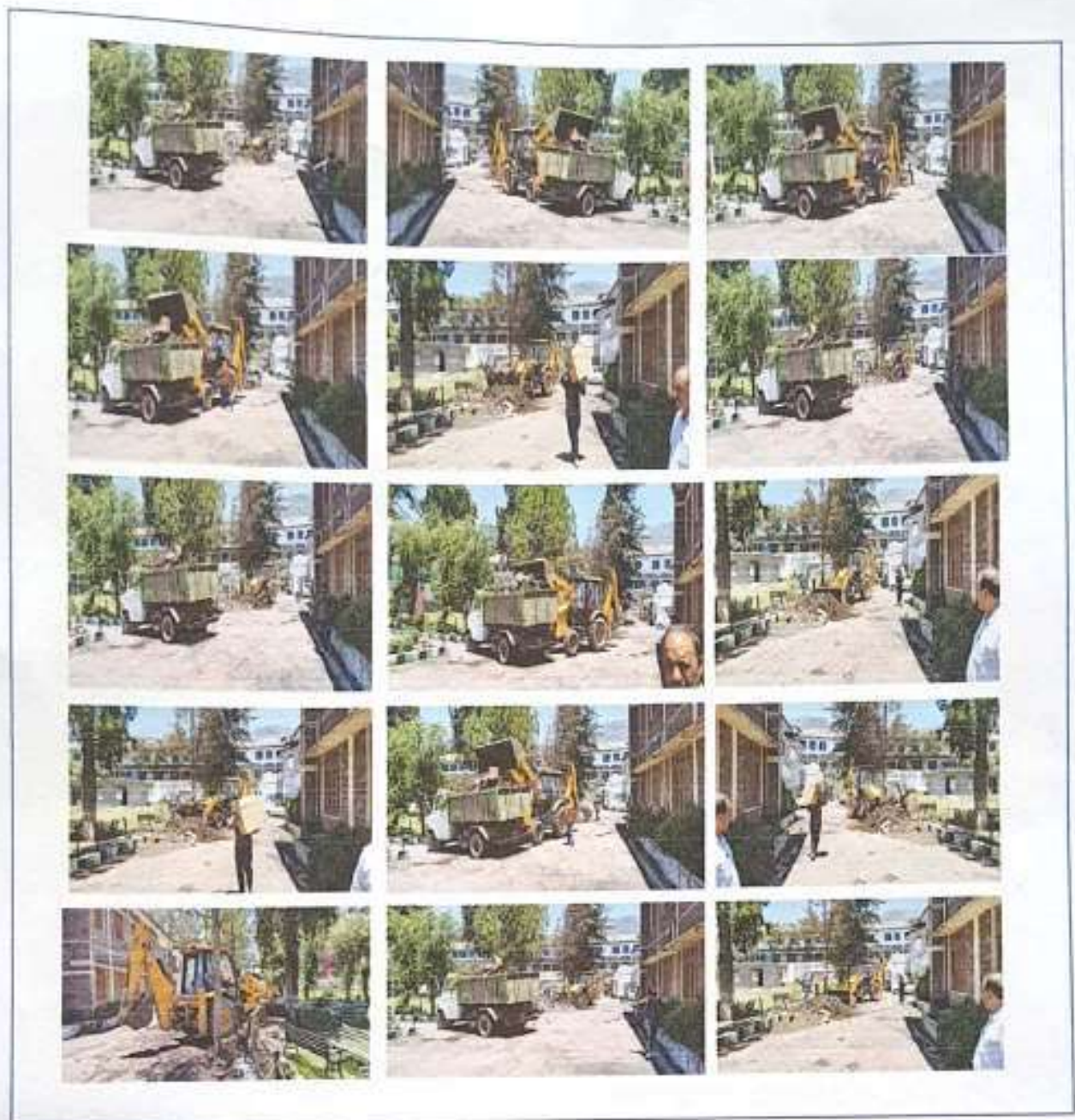
**Step 2 Compost pit and waste bin** A compost pit was made by the students for depositing biodegradable waste. A cylindrical iron waste bin (of 1m diameter and 1m height) was made for depositing the paper & plastic waste. Once in a week, the students sort out the plastic and it was taken by the municipality.

**Step 3 Awareness campaign:** An awareness campaign was conducted a group of active members of students visited each class and spoke a few words about the need to keep our campus neat and clean. The dangers caused by plastic were discussed and the decision to declare the campus as plastic free was announced in the assembly. A detailed awareness speech was made in the assembly.

**Step 4 The campus was declared as plastic free by the principal:** With the help of the students, teachers and all others, we expect that the campus can be maintained as plastic free forever. Even though we have arranged this type of a waste management system in the campus, we know about some possible challenges that we may come across, since our campus is often used for some general functions by the Administrative Department. Any way, we are satisfied that at least some students are always alert on maintaining the campus as well as the earth free of plastic.

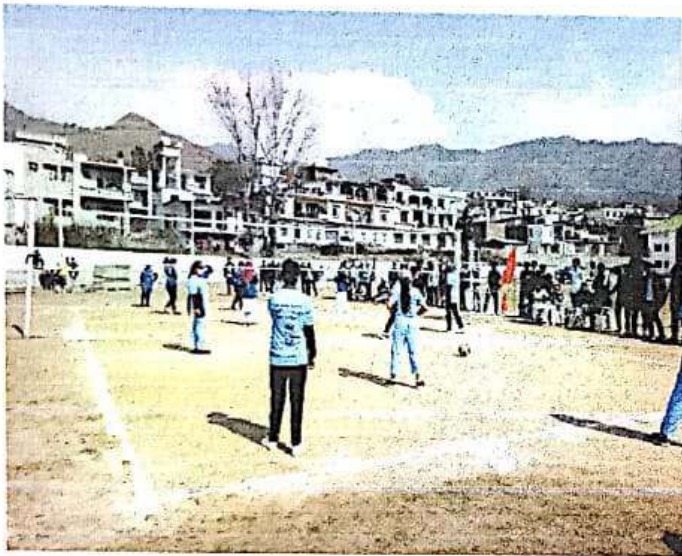
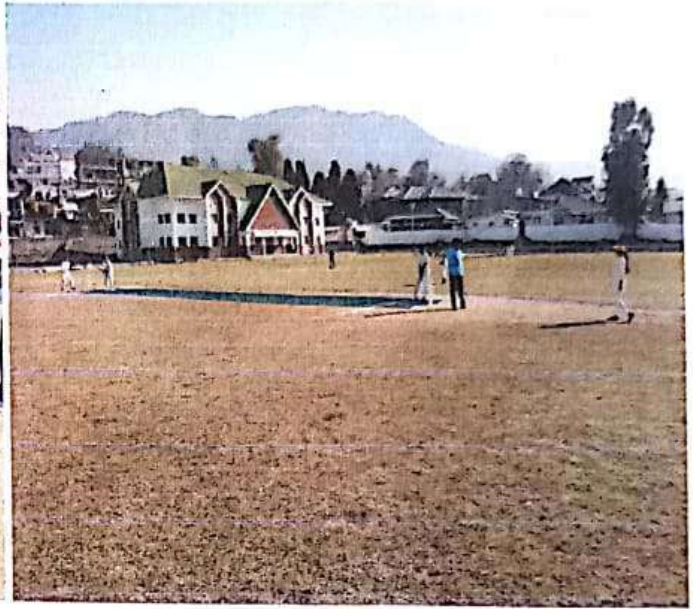

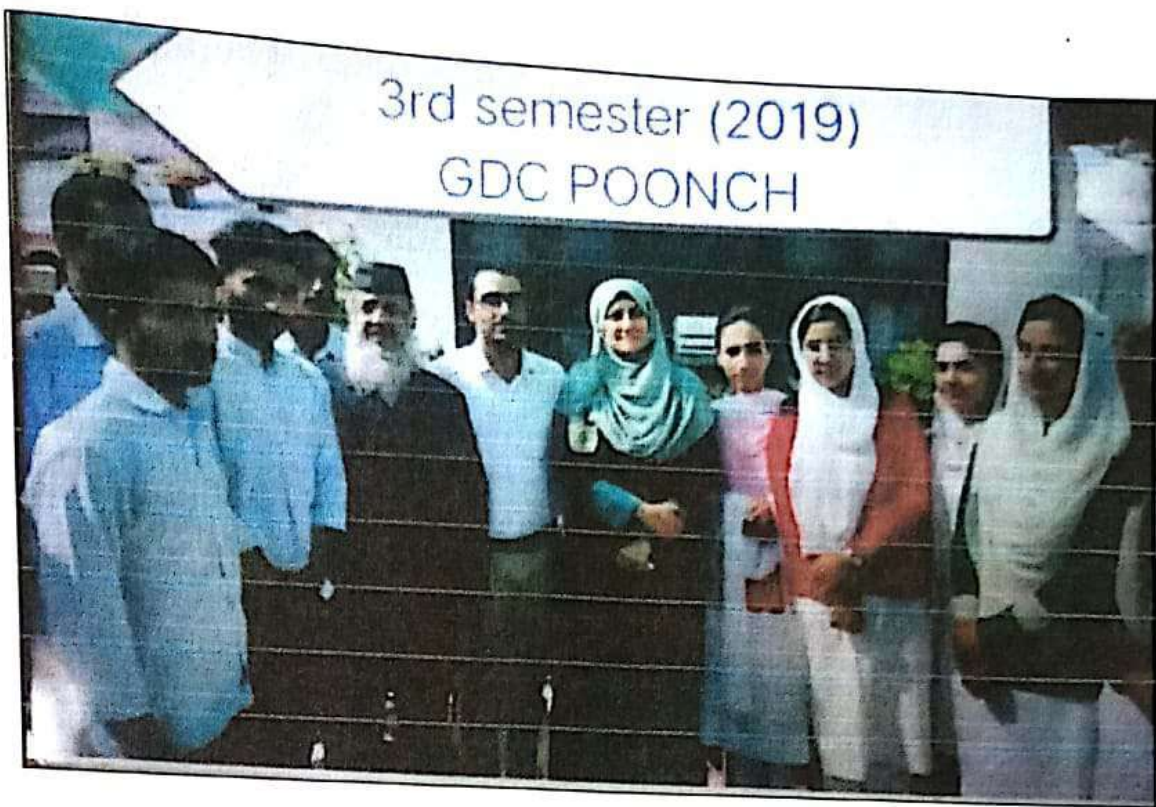

The program was organized with all precautionary measures, maintaining social distance and wearing mask in view of COVID-19.



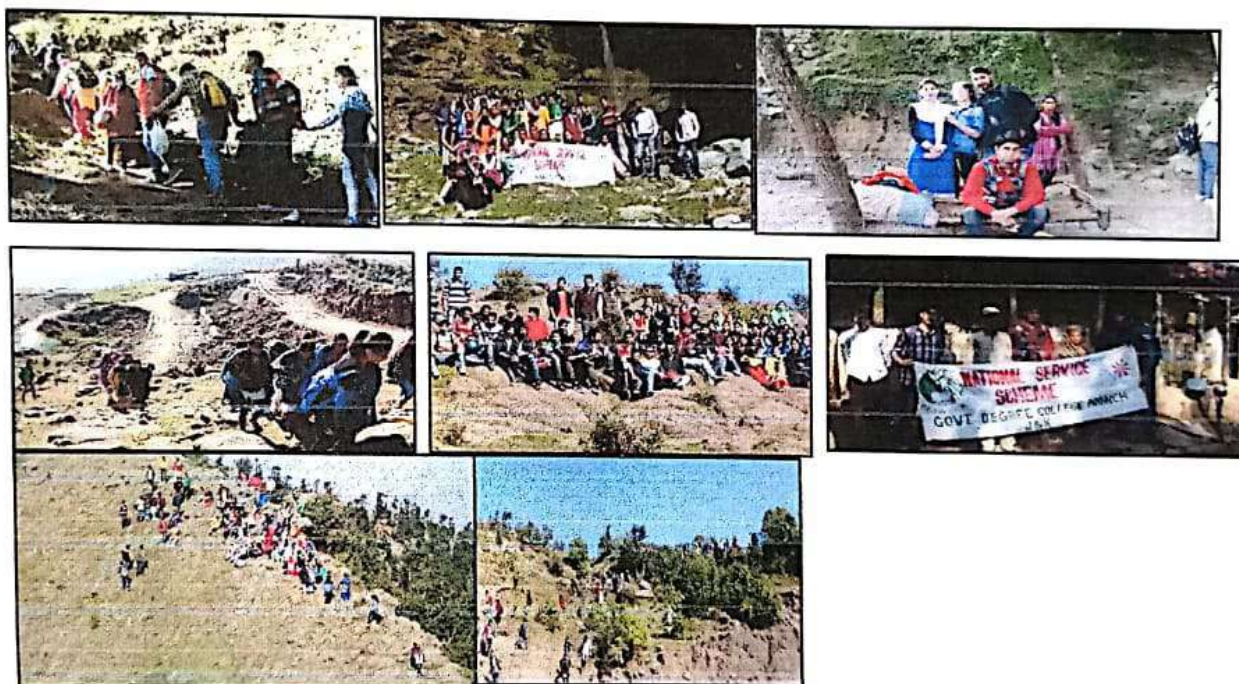

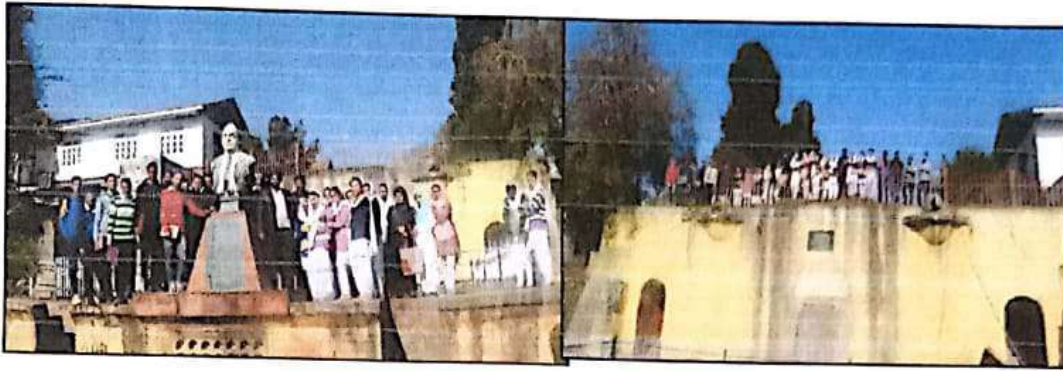
### Heritage walk organized 2-12-2016

Then they were taken to Sheesh Mahal, another important historical place, which is now housed by Girls Higher Secondary School. The old monument is located in the centre and is encircled by new building for class rooms, is in much depleted position and calling for immediate its restoration .GhulamNabi Azad, then CM has ordered for its restoration and shifting of school to an another place but nothing has done till date.



They also visited a famous Fort, which is 1000 years old and constructed by Raja Rustam Khan. It remained a seat of governance of erstwhile Poonch State upto 1947 and after partition this fort was used as mini secretariat for all government departments and it was badly damaged during 2005 earthquake and was declared unsafe and consequently all the offices were shifted from this fort. Archaeology Department of India adopted it for its restoration. But wild plants, grass and bushes engulf the whole fort. People of the surrounding use it as toilet and dumping place and gamblers were seen playing cards in its premises.

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The volunteers also visited “BaghDeodhi” (Gate of Garden) near bus stand, now it is also known as gate of Poonch town. This building maintained its glory to some extent .It is a two story building and is housed by some religious organization.
